

# Varmint Hunting

Klamath Basin Varmint Hunting – Southern Oregon

Affectionately known as squeak hunting we shoot squirrels from the Varmint Extermination Unit (VEU) in the Klamath Basin. Our hunts are on private property and are available for groups of two to four people. Most days we shoot 200 to 600 rounds per person. Shooting range is from 5 feet to 2,000 yards. (Depends on your gun and you.) We invite you to come and do your part for society and curb the explosive population of these damaging rodents!

## A Few Rules & Tips:

Consumption of alcohol is not allowed within 8 hours before hunting begins or during hunting hours.

Smoking is not allowed unless on a paved or graveled road. All cigarette butts must be fully extinguished and carried out with you.

Hunting can be a dangerous sport. Please give our office an emergency phone number before you arrive.

Some hunting conditions can be strenuous. If you have any physical needs or limitations such as limited walking, or squatting that may affect your hunt please notify our office BEFORE you arrive. We can make arrangements to meet the needs of our guests with physical challenges and special needs but we must know in advance so we can be prepared.

Please contact our office with where you plan to stay before you arrive so we know how to reach you. We need to confirm a meeting time and place with you each evening before your hunt the following day. If you need lodging information please call our office.

Please follow your guide's instructions. This is very important to the safety and success of your hunt. Your guides know what works in many types of situations. Please feel free to give suggestions, but in the end, you've hired a guide for a reason. Let their knowledge and experience work for you/

**CANCELLATION & PAYMENT POLICY:** Deposits are not refundable for any reason if the client cancels. If Roe Outfitters LLC cancels a hunt due to hazardous conditions we will refund the client's money or offer to reschedule. A 50% NONREFUNDABLE deposit is required to reserve dates. The balance is due BEFORE the hunt. Hunts cancelled less than 21 days in advance are payable in full.

**WEATHER:** We hunt rain, snow or shine. We cannot predict weather patterns. If a hunt does not go well due to weather we do not refund a clients money. Dealing with weather is a normal part of the hunting experience.

**SAFETY:** Roe Outfitters LLC reserves the right to cancel a hunt at the client's expense if the client has been drinking within 8 hours before their hunt or if client is careless with gun safety. Gun safety is given the utmost consideration. Warnings are not necessary with regard to gun safety. A guide can and will cancel a hunt at the clients expense if the client is in any way jeopardizing the safety of those around him or her.
