SEASON: October – January

BIRDS: Wild Quail – Mountain & Valley Quail

COST: Day shoots are \$300 per person with a two person minimum. Lodging packages are available.

GUIDES: All hunts are guided with up to 3 shooters per guide.

DOGS: Dog(s) are provided however, you are welcome to use your own dogs. Please let our office know in advance if you plan to use your own dog(s). We typically use German Short Hairs.

GROUP SIZE: We hunt up to three people per guide.

PROPERTY: We hunt private and public ground in Southern Oregon. Most lands are in and around Klamath County.

TERRAIN: Most properties have irrigated farmland, natural grasses, rolling hills and farm roads. Some conditions will be more demanding with steeper terrain and heavy vegetation.

CANCELLATION & PAYMENT POLICY: Deposits are not refundable for any reason if the client cancels. If Roe Outfitters LLC cancels a hunt due to hazardous conditions, as determined by the guide, we will refund the client's money or reschedule. A 50% NONREFUNDABLE deposit is required to reserve any dates. The balance is due BEFORE the hunt.

WEATHER: We hunt rain, snow or shine. We cannot predict weather patterns. If a hunt does not go well due to weather we do not refund a clients money. Dealing with weather is a normal part of the hunting experience.

SAFETY: Roe Outfitters LLC reserves the right to cancel a hunt at the client's expense if the client has been drinking before their hunt or if client is careless with gun safety. Gun safety is given the utmost consideration. Warnings are not necessary with regard to gun safety. A guide can and will cancel a hunt at the clients expense if the client is in any way jeopardizing the safety of those around him or her.

GEAR LIST:

Shotgun

rain gear

hunter's orange hat or shirt. (Roe Outfitters hats are available for purchase in hunters orange \$15)

Lead shot may be used and 6's are recommended for mountain quail and 7 ½ for valley quail.

Ankle high boots (You will be walking through grasses and brush)

Pants with an extra layer of thigh covering is helpful.

Cooler for transporting birds.

Daypack

Waterbottle

Snow is very likely so be prepared for cold and wet weather conditions (bibs and coats)

Insulated boots
